



Volunteer Tutors

Volunteers are required to tutor children and youth in care who are in need of extra help achieving their full academic potential. Volunteer Tutors assist children and youth to experience success in learning through a supportive, one-to-one relationship. Children and youth requiring assistance range from ages 6 to 18 and all academic levels. Scheduling can be arranged directly with the resource parents and the tutor at your mutual convenience.

Major Responsibilities	Requirements/Qualifications
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Act as a sensitive and caring learning guide enabling the child or youth to discover their own strengths as a student. Model healthy study skills and positive approaches to school work. Tutoring can be held at the Halton CAS office, a library or the child/youth's foster home, as mutually agreeable. Advise the worker and Supervisor of Volunteer Services of any concerns or problems that may arise during tutoring sessions. Adhere to the guidelines of the Halton CAS Code of Conduct. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General knowledge of material to be learned. Interest in and ability to relate well to children, youth and families. Complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening. Be fully vaccinated and provide receipt of vaccination. Patience, flexibility and non-judgemental attitude. Experience in teaching is an asset.
